





An amber-colored Vienna Style Lager Beer with toasted nutty hints. Soft, elegant, and complex, with just enough Noble hop presence to provide a balanced finish.

Although rarely brewed in its home city of Vienna, Austria, this close relative to the Oktoberfest and Märzen styles of beer has been well-popularized elsewhere. Before the invention of mechanized kilning, maltsters would dry their germinated barley over direct heat or fire, resulting in a darker, often smoky, malt that was difficult to make consistent. When central European brewers learned of forced -air kiln drying already in place in England, a pale malt revolution in continental Europe began. Vienna lagers were released alongside Märzen in 1841. One year later Pilsner hit the market. Although today extremely pale, straw -colored, crystal -clear beers are common, this early pale/amber lager style was novel at the time, as it was a very light color compared with its predecessors.
